TEQUILA

Agave grows differently depending on the terrior from the Valley to Los Altos. Ageing also will change the flavour profile of the Tequila. The 4 categories are as follows:

Plata/Blanco	bottled straight off the still or rested for up to 2 months.
Reposado	aged for a minimum of 2 months in oak or stainless.
Añejo	aged for a minimum of 1 year in oak Barrels no larger than 600L.
Extra Añejo	aged for more than 3 years in oak Barrels.

HERRADURA

A Valley tequila, founded in the town of Amattan. Herradura tequila is a leader within the industry, creating the Reposado and Extra Añejo categories with 25 million agaves growing onsite, and one of the last remaining Haciendas.
